Albert R. Goldsmith Teacher Award

- The Albert R. Goldsmith Teacher Award was established to honor a lifelong CEC member who left a very generous donation in his estate to DPHMD.
- Mr. Goldsmith was a teacher of students who were served in home placements in Pennsylvania; he made contributions in numerous ways to his community that impacted the lives of children with and without disabilities.
- The award grants \$250 to a teacher for instructional materials for students in general or special education classrooms, home settings, or hospital settings. Up to two awards will be given annually to teachers who teach students birth through 22 years old who have physical, health, or multiple disabilities.

The Albert R. Goldsmith Teacher Award will provide a color laser printer and ink that will give Krystal's students access to color visuals.
