

CEC 2022 Accessibility Guidelines

For Posters

Updated September 2021

Adapted from APA Accessibility Guidelines, March 2019

Make it visually accessible

- Title size: 72- 158, the title should be viewable from 10-15 feet to catch the attention of the reader
- Section title: 46-56 point font
- Body text: ideal is 36 point, but should be at least 24-36
- Offer to describe the poster or bring a CD/ USB for attendees who are blind or have visual impairments
- Use sans serif fonts like Helvetica and Veranda
- Use contrasting colors between background and foreground colors

Make it audibly accessible

- Address the audience member with a clear voice, make sure to annunciate
- If attendee is using an interpreter, speak directly to the attendee, not the interpreter.
