

#### Here's a look at the student process

For remote assessments students are tested individually in a quiet, confidential environment, monitored by a support person who is directed by the remote school psychologist and has no clinical duties. Students view the stimuli on the computer screen and respond just as they would in person.

The student also uses a document camera that enables the school psychologist to observe them as they complete their responses in the booklet or use manipulatives.

Using the similar techniques and materials as traditional paperbased evaluations, Presence school psychologists use our secure online platform to complete:
