## How to Get Insurance or Medicaid to Cover Scanning Pens

Scanning Pens like the C-Pen Reader 2, Reader 3, or Lingo 3 may qualify as assistive technology and be eligible for insurance or Medicaid reimbursement when prescribed by a licensed provider.



## Who Qualifies

- Individuals with documented reading disabilities (e.g., dyslexia)
- Students with IEPs or 504 plans
- Those with ADHD or other learning challenges

## Why It Qualifies

Scanning Pens are considered assistive technology under IDEA and ADA. They support reading fluency and comprehension for individuals who struggle with decoding text.

## Required Documentation

- Letter of Medical Necessity (LMN) from a licensed provider (SLP, OT, physician)
- Diagnosis and functional limitations
- Description of the device and how it supports educational or daily living needs

## Common CPT Codes

- 97755 - Assistive technology assessment
- 97535 - Self-care/home management training using assistive devices
- 97537 - Community/work reintegration training involving assistive technology
